Clemson Elevate Metrics

Lisa Knox, Angie Leidinger, and Bob Jones presented. They discussed the Clemson Elevate timeline, FY24 priorities and highlights, and a review of FY25 priorities. FY25 priorities included investments in well-being planning, military and veteran engagement, the College of Veterinary Medicine, Workday ERP Implementation, improved research infrastructure, and facilities long-range plan alignment, among others.
